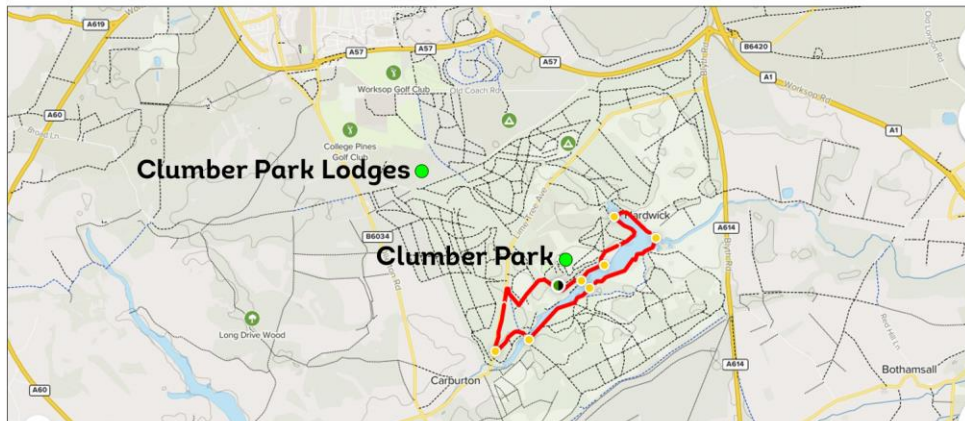
CLUMBER PARK



A circular trail around Clumber Park, our neighbouring estate managed by the National Trust in Nottinghamshire.

The route will give you chance to see many of the park's key features including Clumber Lake, Clumber Bridge, Clumber Chapel (often referred to as the Cathedral in Miniature) and a section of Limetree Avenue (the longest double-lined avenue of lime trees in Europe).

The route is fairly flat with no stiles or gates. There are a couple of short flights of steps and some of the paths can get a little muddy and uneven but generally the ground is very good, so the route would be suitable for a rugged pushchair.
